OUR HISTORY

1978 Dr. Jerry Young's vision is realized and ground is broken for the first wing of LCS that housed 44 students

1982 Groundbreaking for the second educational wing - LCS now offers 2 programs for students in grades K to 7

1991 MorningStar Christian Daycare, Preschool and Kindergarten (Early Learning Center) is established

1996 First graduating class

2004 ACSI and Middle States Accreditation is earned

2016 LCS and ELC become an independent organization with their own 501(c)3 status

2022 LCS and ELC will move from its home of 44 years on W. Lincoln Ave to LCOB for three years and then into a permanent home

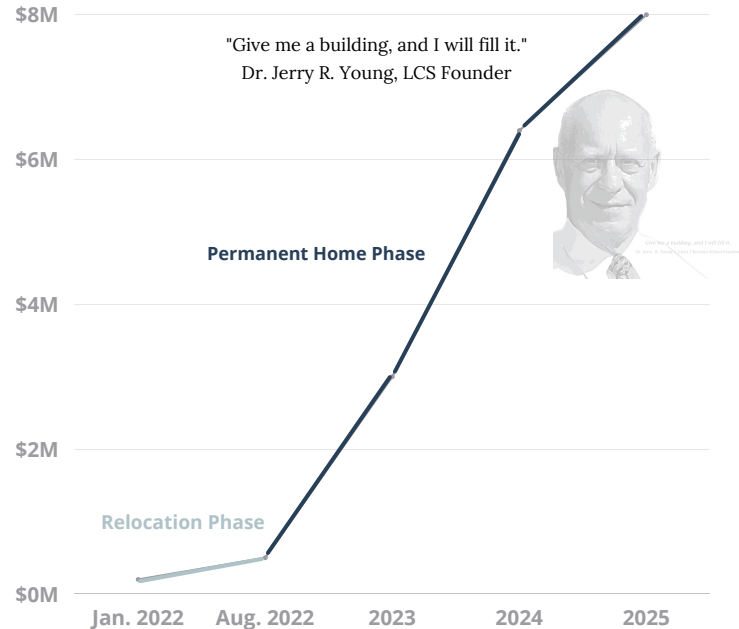

OUR PLAN

Our capital campaign will come in two phases. The **Relocation Phase** will run from January until August 2022 to raise the funds we need to move to Lititz Church of the Brethren. This move will cost approximately **\$300,000**.

The second phase will last about three years. In that time, the Advancement Team will raise the money needed to move to a **Permanent Home** where our students can continue to receive biblically-based education and impact the world for Christ. It is anticipated that the capital needed will be between **\$7-10M**.





OUR PLAN

Relocation Phase \approx \$300,000 (by 8/2022)

- Optimize IT infrastructure
- Update building security
- Snow and trash removal, utilities
- Remove walls
- Install lockers and whiteboards
- Build small playground and install fencing
- Storage units

Permanent Home Phase \approx \$7-10M (by 2025)

Capital raised will be used to purchase and retrofit a building or to purchase land and build. The Relocation Committee of the Board of Education continues its search for Lititz Christian School's new permanent home.
