When shorts are worn they must have a four inch inseam or longer. Athletic pants and sweatpants may be worn but may not be form fitting. Pajama pants are not permitted. | Pants & Skirts Pants/skirts should not be see-through, tight, or revealing. They may have rips/holes/frays if solid leggings are worn underneath. Girls are permitted to wear leggings as long as their shirt fully covers their hips and upper thighs. Long pants or capris must be worn during the school day except for when participating in PE; Capri length must be below the knee when sitting. Shorts are permitted during the months of August, September, May, and June. When shorts are worn they must have a four inch inseam or longer. Athletic pants and sweatpants may be worn but may not be form fitting. Pajama pants are not permitted. Skirt & dress length must be no more than three inches above the top of the knee, even while sitting. Solid leggings may only be worn under skirts and dresses. |
