Parent/Player Agreement

Lititz Christian Athletics supports the Mission of Lititz Christian School through its dedication to **DEVELOPING CHRIST-LIKE CHAMPIONS** through the rigors of interscholastic competition. In so doing, all student-athletes are expected to abide by the Lititz Christian School Handbook as well as the following Athletic Department specific expectations.

Please take the time to read over this document carefully and thoughtfully. This agreement must be initialed and signed by both athlete and parent and turned in by **Monday, August 5** to the Athletic Director. *(Individual teams may have additional expectations to be met in order to be in good standing for their particular sport. Please consult your team's coach regarding these requirements)*

Agreement 1: PRACTICES & GAMES Initialed: _____

Attendance at all scheduled practices and games is required; they are not optional! The only exceptions are absences from school or when prior arrangements have been approved by the head coach. Additionally, parents are to ensure that their children are promptly picked up after practices and games have concluded.

Agreement 2: TARDIES & ABSENCES Initialed: _____

Student-athletes not in school by 11:00am, may not participate in any practice, game, or team activity that day. Exceptions may be granted if prior approval for a late tardy or absence was granted by the Lititz Christian School office.

Agreement 3: ACADEMIC STANDING Initialed: _____

In order to be in good academic standing with Lititz Christian School and thus eligible to participate in athletic activities, a student-athletes may not have any grades below a 60% (F) and may only have one grade below a 70% (D). In season athletes will be subject to weekly Grade Checks to ensure they meet this standard. Student-athletes not meeting this standard will be subject to disciplinary action as outlined in the LCS Student Handbook.

Agreement 4: SPORTSMANSHIP Initialed: _____

All athletes, parents and fans are expected to act in ways that support the Vision, Mission and Values and LC Athletics. Please cheer loudly for our EAGLE teams, but not against our opponents or officials. Athletes whose actions have been detrimental to the objectives of LC Athletics may face disciplinary action. Parents or fans exhibiting unsportsmanlike behavior may be subject to removal from the contest and/or banned from future events.

Agreement 5: UNIFORM CARE Initialed: _____

Parents/Athletes are responsible for the proper usage, care and cleaning of uniforms. Uniforms that are damaged or destroyed due to negligence or improper care/cleaning will need to be replaced by the Parent/Athlete. A charge of \$200 will be allotted for any jersey, short or other part of the uniform owned by Lititz Christian School.

Agreement 6: CELL PHONE USE

LC Athletics permits cell phone usage after 2:45pm before practices begin or during travel to and from contests since these are primarily "down times" for our student-athletes. Coaches have the discretion to limit cell phone use during these down times if they feel such use is having a detrimental effect on the student-athletes preparation for practices and/or contests. Cell phones are not to be used during games or practices except for emergency situations as approved by a coach (e.g. injury, illness, approved early departure, etc.)
